# OFFICIAL RULES

- One entry per child. Posters must be no larger than 12 inches x 18 inches.
- Create an original poster based on the general theme “From Farmers’ Fields to Your Family’s Table.” Artwork subjects may include:  
Farmers harvesting crops – Family dinner table – Farm scenes and equipment – Harvesters giving food to families in need – Community food drives – Food from farm crops (milk, eggs, vegetables, bread, fruit, honey, etc.) – Farm animals that provide food (dairy cows, chickens, hogs, beef cattle, etc.)
- The design may be in any art medium (paints, crayon, colored pencil, markers, etc.).
- All entries and all rights to these entries become the sole and exclusive property of the National Agricultural Center and Hall of Fame. No entries will be returned.

## Judging

- Entries will be judged on theme message, artistic ability and overall design.
- Families of Ag Hall of Fame and Harvesters employees and Board of Directors members and Ag Hall of Fame Board of Governors members are not eligible.
- By participating, entrant grants sponsor permission to use their full name, likeness and caption, for publicity purposes in connection with this contest in any and all media without additional compensation, notification or permission, unless restricted by law.
- Entries must be received by 5 p.m. May 5. Winners will be notified by May 19.
